1. What were some takeaways from the sermon? What convicted you? What stood out to you? Explain.
2. What question did the disciples ask Jesus? And How did Jesus respond? (18:1-3)
3. What does it mean to become like children in verse 3? What is the difference between having childlike faith and being immature in your faith?
4. How does the requirement of humility in verses 1-4 compare with our culture's view of greatness?
5. Based on this text, how would you explain or define humility?
6. What do you sense God prompting you to do today to humble yourself, to become more like a little child?
7. What does Jesus say about a believer who leads others into sin, directly or indirectly?
8. What are the consequences of sin? Why are the consequences so severe for those who lead others astray?

9. Is there a humility needed to fight sin?

10. Are there any sins in your life you need to wage war with? Why is it important to wage war against sin in light of our relationships with others? (Romans 8:13)

11. What are some practical steps to live with humility and strive for holiness?
